MREŽE I ČLANSTVA / NETWORKS AND MEMBERSHIPS

BirdLife International

BirdLife International je globalno partnerstvo organizacija koje teže očuvanju ptica, njihovih staništa i globalne biološke raznolikosti. BirdLife International je široko priznat kao svetski lider u zaštiti ptica. Nauka i praktične aktivnosti na terenu na važnim područjima i staništima, omogućavaju sprovođenje uspešnih programa očuvanja ptica i njihovih staništa.

Mreža okuplja preko 120 BirdLife partnera širom sveta. Članovi mreže su po jedan predstavnik iz zemalja Evrope, Azije i Afrike, čime je Društvo ukazano izuzetno poverenje. Značajna potvrda našeg rada došla je 2013. kada je Društvo zvanično postalo pridruženi član i predstavnik za Srbiju globalne mreže BirdLife International. Veoma bitna godina za Društvo je 2018. kada postaje punopravan član i deo porodice BirdLife International.



BirdLife International is a global partnership of conservation organisations (NGOs) that strives to conserve birds, their habitats and global biodiversity. BirdLife is widely recognised as the world leader in bird conservation. Science together with practical activities on the ground in important sites and habitats enable the implementation of successful conservation programmes for birds and their habitats.

The network brings together over 120 BirdLife partners worldwide. The members of the network are one representative per country of Europe, Asia and Africa, which means that the BPSSS is extremely trusted. Significant confirmation of our work came in 2013, when the BPSSS officially became an associate member and representative of Serbia in this global BirdLife International network. A very important year for the Society is 2018, when BPSSS becomes a full member and part of the BirdLife International family.

BioNET mreža / The Network of Biodiversity Related Civil Society Organizations in South-East Europe

U cilju boljeg povezivanja organizacija na području jugoistočne Evrope koje se bave očuvanjem biodiverziteta pokrenuta je neformalna mreža BioNET. Inicijativa je pokrenuta u okviru projekta vođenog od strane Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH. Cilj mreže jeste stvaranje okruženja za poboljšanje očuvanja prirode i promocija održivog razvoja u skladu sa nacionalnim strategijama, regionalnim prioritetima, EU Direktive o pticama i staništima i drugim relevantnim dokumentima.



An informal network – BioNET, has been launched for better connection of biodiversity-related organizations in Southeast Europe. The initiative was launched as part of a project led by Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH. The aim of the network is to create an environment for improving nature conservation and promoting sustainable development in accordance with national strategies, regional priorities, the EU Birds and Habitats Directive and other relevant documents.

SEENET mreža / South East Europe Network for Energy and Transport (SEENET)



SEENET mreža okuplja organizacije koje se bave zaštitom prirode i životne sredine u jugoistočnoj Evropi u cilju uspostavljanja održivog korišćenja energije i transporta u ovom delu Evrope. Misija mreže je da obezbedi platformu za saradnju na regionalnom nivou i da se obezbedi aktivno učešće ekoloških NVO u regionu i međunarodnim procesima bitnim za sektor energetike i saobraćaja, prvenstveno kroz proces javnog zagovaranja.

Koalicija 27 / Coalition 27

Koalicija je osnovana 2014. godine, prvenstveno radi monitoringa i doprinosa pregovorima u poglavlu 27. Danas, Koalicija 27 okuplja organizacije civilnog društva koje zajedno nastupaju, zagovaraju i podstiču učešće javnosti u procesu pristupnih pregovora Republike Srbije sa Evropskom unijom u oblasti zaštite životne sredine i klimatskih promena.



The Coalition was formed in 2014, primarily to monitor and contribute to the negotiations in Chapter 27. Today, Coalition 27 brings together civil society organizations to jointly advocate and encourage public participation in the Serbia's EU accession negotiations in the field of environmental protection and climate change.

NATURA 2000 Resursni Centar Srbije / Natura 2000 Resource center of Serbia



Mreža OCD "Natura 2000 resursni centar Srbije" osnovana je sa ciljem da doprinese rešenjima i mogućim preporukama za stvaranje i monitoringa evropske ekološke mreže Natura 2000 u Srbiji. Trenutno je u mreži više od 60 članica, udruženja građana čija je osnovna delatnost u vezi sa zaštitom prirode i životne sredine. Ciljevi mreže su: 1) očuvanje biološke raznovrsnosti u skladu sa ekonomskim, socijalnim, kulturnim i naučnim razvojem; 2) povezivanje, podrška i razvoj organizacija koje bi kao punopravni partneri, u saradnji sa drugim organizacijama i institucijama, radile na uspostavljanju Natura 2000 mreže u Srbiji.

The network of CSOs "Natura 2000 Resource Center of Serbia" was established with the aim of contributing to solutions and possible recommendations for the creation and monitoring of the European ecological network Natura 2000 in Serbia. Currently, there are more than 60 members in the network, citizens' associations whose main activity is related to the protection of nature and the environment. The objectives of the network are: 1) conservation of biological diversity in accordance with economic, social, cultural and scientific development; 2) connecting, supporting and developing organizations that would, as full partners, in cooperation with other organizations and institutions, work on the establishment of the Natura 2000 network in Serbia.

Formiranje funkcionalnog sistema odmorišta i zimovališta duž Jadranskog selidbenog puta / *Forming a functional resting area and wintering grounds along the Adriatic migration route – Adriatic Flyway 4 - Safe Flyways – stop illegal bird killing in the Mediterranean*

CILJ

Generalni cilj projekta je da smanji uticaj nezakonitog ubijanja ptica na brojnost populacija krivolovljenih vrsta ptica kako na nacionalnom, tako i na međunarodnom nivou, jer na istom problemu rade i partnerske organizacije u okruženju. Ciljevi koji su više u skladu sa borbom protiv krivolova u Srbiji su usmereni na sledeće:

- povećanju znanja o ilegalnom ubijanju ptica;
- povećanju svesti i podsticanju javnosti da učestvuju u zaustavljanju ilegalnog ubijanja ptica;
- nastojanju da se osigura politička posvećenost sprovođenju akcija za zaustavljanje ilegalnog ubijanja ptica;
- održavanje i jačanje postojeće mreže organizacija civilnog društva i lokalnih grupa za zaštitu koji rade zajedno na rešavanju ilegalnog ubijanja ptica.

AKTIVNOSTI

- Širom Srbije organizovano je 26 izleta u okviru Evropskog vikenda posmatranja ptica. Izlete je posetilo 935 ljubitelja prirode, koji su posmatrali 37.435 jedinki ptica iz 134 različitih vrsta. Najčešće vrste su čvorak, obični galeb i gluvara.

THE GOAL

The overall goal of the project is to lower the negative effect of illegal killing and tacking on the game bird population, both nationally and internationally, as our partner organizations in the neighbouring countries are dealing with the same challenges. The main goals aimed at reducing poaching in Serbia include:

- Increasing knowledge about the illegal killing and tacking of birds;
- Raising awareness and creating a public incentive towards stopping illegal killing and tacking of birds;
- Taking action to ensure political commitment towards concrete measures aimed at stopping illegal killing and tacking of birds;
- Maintaining and strengthening the existing networks of NGOs and local environmentalist groups that work together on solving illegal killing and tacking of birds.

ACTIVITIES

- Across Serbia, 26 excursions were organized as part of the European Bird-watching Weekend. Excursions were visited by 935 nature lovers, who observed 37,435 birds in 134 different species. The most common species are Common starlings, Black-headed gulls and Mallards.

- Prstenovački kamp, održan na Labudovom oknu, trajao je mesec dana, tokom kojih je oko 50 posetilaca upoznato sa ornitofaunom ptica ovog kraja.
- Izrađena su tri promotivna videa o lepotama Labudovog okna.
- Započeta saradnja sa Lovačkom komorom Srbije u okviru koje je održano predavanje na temu prepoznavanja ptica. Predavanju su prisustvovali lovočuvari širom Srbije.
- Ostvarena saradnja sa Udruženjem tužilaca Srbije i zamenika tužilaca Srbije, kroz pravno savetovanje, zajedničke radionice, radu na pisanju vodiča i blogova.
- Radom na terenu, tokom avgusta i septembra, otkriveno je 55 slučaja krivolova uz upotrebu vabilica, od čega su 62 vabilice uklonjene.
- Organizovan kamp sa ciljem monitoringu i prijavljivanja slučajeva nelegalnog hvatanja ptica u okolini Leskovca. Za samo 4 dana, otkriveno je 34 slučaja.

- *The bird ringing camp, held at Labudovo okno, lasted a month, during which around 50 visitors were introduced to the bird ornithofauna of this area.*
- *BPSSS produced three promotional videos about the beauties of the Labudovo okno.*
- *Cooperation with the Hunting Chamber of Serbia has begun, within which a lecture on bird recognition was held. The lecture was attended by gamekeepers throughout Serbia.*
- *Achieved cooperation with the Association of Prosecutors of Serbia and Deputy Prosecutors of Serbia, through legal advice, joint workshops, work on writing guides and blogs.*
- *During the field work, during August and September, 55 cases of poaching with the use of decoys were discovered, and 52 decoys were removed.*
- *BPSSS organized a camp with the aim of monitoring and reporting cases of illegal bird hunting in the vicinity of Leskovac. In just 4 days 34 cases were discovered.*

CILJ

Cilj projekta je da smanji uticaj infrastrukture za prenos energije na uginuće ptica, kako na nacionalnom nivou, tako i na internacionalnom nivou, jer na istom problemu rade i partnerske organizacije u okruženju.

AKTIVNOSTI

- Sprovedene su aktivnosti na terenu u cilju prikupljanja podataka o stradanjima ptica usled elektrokućije i kolizije.
- Postavljeno je 7 platformi za rode u saradnji sa ED Zrenjanin.
- U saradnji sa Pokrajinskim zavodom za zaštitu prirode i Elektromrežom Srbije, organizovan je stručni skup o aktivnostima u okviru Sporazuma o saradnji na realizaciji zaštite stepskog sokola u 2020. i 2021. godini.

THE GOAL

The goal of the project is to lower the negative effects of electrical energy related infrastructure on bird populations, nationally and internationally, as our partner organizations in the neighboring countries are dealing with the same challenges.

ACTIVITIES

- Field activities were implemented in order to collect data on electrocuted and collided birds.
- 7 nesting platforms for the White storks were set up in the cooperation with Electrodistribution company Zrenjanin.
- In cooperation with the Institution for Nature Protection of Vojvodina Province and ED Elektromreža Srbija, an expert meeting on the activities within the Agreement on Cooperation in the Implementation of the Protection of the Saker falcon in 2020 and 2021 was organized.

CILJ

Generalni cilj projekta je da smanji uticaj trovanja ptica i divljih životinja na brojnost njihovih populacija. Ciljevi koji su više u skladu sa borbom protiv trovanja u Srbiji su usmereni na sledeće:

- podizanje svesti javnosti i ostalih bitnih aktera;
- poboljšanje znanja o situaciji u Srbiji kroz praćenje problema;
- izgradnja kapaciteta i obuka NVO i zainteresovanih strana.

AKTIVNOSTI

- Sprovedene su aktivnosti na terenu koje podrazumevaju istraživanje slučajeva trovanja i dalje obaveštavanje nadležnih institucija.
- Pokrenuta kampanja o upotrebni olovne sačme, promotivni spot sa ovom tematikom je prezentovan na društvenim medijima.
- Pokrenuta je anketa o stavovima građana na temu trovanja. Jedan od zaključaka je da su građani svesni opasnosti koju trovanje životinja povlači sa sobom i da bi slučajevi prijavljivali nadležnim organima, ali da je nivo poverenja nizak.

THE GOAL

The aim of the project is to lower the negative effects that poisoning of birds and other animals has on their population abundances. The goals aimed at the fight against poisoning in Serbia include:

- *Raising awareness of the general public and other stakeholders;*
- *Increasing the knowledge of the scope of this problem in Serbia through research and monitoring;*
- *Capacity building and training NGOs and other stakeholders.*

ACTIVITIES

- *Field activities that include investigating poisoning cases and further informing the competent institutions were implemented.*
- *A campaign on the use of lead shot was launched and a promotional video on this topic was presented on social media.*
- *A survey on citizens' attitudes on the topic of poisoning was launched. One of the conclusions is that the citizens are aware of the danger that animal poisoning brings with it and that they would report the cases to the competent authorities, but the level of trust is low.*

THE GOAL

Protection of the remaining nests and pairs of the Eastern Imperial Eagle in Serbia, through conservation of nests during the breeding period, cleaning and revitalization of habitats where the species feed, monitoring the state of the population, agreements with the locals and users of the area where the eagles live, recording and reporting cases of endangering eagles, monitoring of bird poisoning in the Vojvodina area and more.

ACTIVITIES

- 18th Pannonian Eagle Census;
- Monitoring and nest guarding;
- Four nesting platforms have been set up;
- Publication "Wildlife Crime - A guide to the use of forensic and specialist techniques in the investigation of wildlife crime";

AKTIVNOSTI

- Analiza problema trovanja – Evidencija i monitoring slučajeva trovanja ili slučajeva povezanih sa trovanjem.

THE GOAL

Build capacities to improve management of poisoning incidents, raise awareness about the severity of this practice while providing other preventative measures, enhance collaborations to improve knowledge exchange among relevant stakeholders and reduce poisoning incidents to help safeguard wildlife, nature and public health.

ACTIVITIES

- Analysis of the problem – Recording and monitoring of poisoning cases or cases related to poisoning.*
- Establishment of working groups – Nomination of working group members.*
- Establishment of national poisoning databases – A platform has been developed for collecting data on the poisoning of wild animals at the level of the Balkans.*
- Investigation of toxic substances – A memorandum of cooperation was signed with the Scientific Institute for Veterinary Science "Novi Sad".*
- Implementation of GPS tracking to tackle poisoning incidents – In December, it was negotiated with the non-governmental organization "Jadovnik" to implement GPS tracking of Griffon Vultures in cooperation with the BPSSS in 2022.*

Rizik od stradanja na dalekovodima predstavlja razlog smrtnosti ptica koji nije dovoljno prepoznat u određenim državama i regionima. Njegov značaj i ozbiljan uticaj koji ima na ugrožene vrste je nepoznat i potcenjen od nadležnih organa i institucija širom sveta. Usled trenutne klimatske i ekološke krize, potreba za zaštitom divljih životinja na našoj Planeti je postala važnija nego ikad. Ptice na dalekovodima stradaju od strujnih udara (elektrokučaja) i sudara sa žicama dalekovoda (kolizija). Ove dve pojave uzrokuju hiljade smrtnih slučajeva i povreda koje bi se mogle izbeći, merama ublažavanja kao što su postavljanje preusmerivača leta i izolatora na najrizičnije dalekovode i žice. Upravo su ove pretnje (elektrokučaj i kolizija) cilj projekta „LIFE Danube Free Sky“, koji predstavlja jedinstveni primer široke međunarodne saradnje duž toka jednog od najvažnijih selidbenih koridora, mesta zauzimanja i zimovanja za mnoge vrste ptica u Evropi - reke Dunav.

AKTIVNOSTI

THE GOAL

The risk of suffering on power lines is a cause of bird mortality that is not sufficiently recognized in certain countries and regions. Its importance and serious impact on endangered species are unknown and underestimated by the authorities and institutions around the world. Due to the current climate and environmental crisis, the need to protect wildlife on our planet has become more important than ever. Birds can die on power lines from electric shock (electrocution) or from crashing with power line wires (collision). These two phenomena cause thousands of deaths and injuries that could be avoided with the installation of mitigation measures such as flight diverters and insulators on the riskiest power lines and wires. These two threats (electrocution and collision) are the goal of the LIFE Danube Free Sky project, which is a unique example of broad international cooperation along the course of one of the most important migration corridors, stopping and wintering sites for many bird species in Europe - the Danube.

ACTIVITIES

- Online bird recognition training was held for the external assistants.*



Istraživanje je pokazalo da se 34 vrste smatraju mogućom gnezdaricom, 34 verovatnom, dok se 29 vrsta smatra potvrđenom gnezdaricom PIO „Vlasina“. Tokom praćenja jesenje seobe zabeleženo je dodatnih 25 vrsta ptica, te ukupan spisak za 2021. godinu iznosi 126 vrsta. Prilikom akcije markiranja ptica na jesenjem prstenovačkom kampu uhvaćeno je i obeleženo ukupno 585 jedinki u okviru 26 vrsta.

THE GOAL

During 2021 in the protected area of "Vlasina" diversity and density of nesting birds was researched in the spring-summer period, while migratory birds were ringed during the autumn.

ACTIVITIES

- During the breeding territories mapping, a total of 2,622 data were collected for 101 bird species, of which 74 were records of Whinchat (*Saxicola rubetra*), 20 records of Corn Buntings (*Emberiza calandra*), 18 records of Corncrake (*Crex crex*), while no Little Egrets (*Egretta garzetta*) and Great White Egrets (*Ardea alba*) were found on the island. The research showed that 34 species are considered possible breeders, 34 as probable breeders, while 29 species are considered as confirmed breeders within the protected area. During the monitoring of autumn migration, an additional 25 species of birds were recorded, and the total list for 2021 is 126 bird species. A total of 585 individuals of 26 species were caught and ringed during the bird ringing camp in the autumn.

Za prikaz trenda njihovih populacija u Srbiji korišćena su dva pokazatelja – veličina gnezdilišnih populacija i trend brojnosti zimujućih populacija celokupnog seta vrsta na osnovu rezultata Međunarodnog zimskog popisa ptica vodenih staništa. Za analizu trendova zimujućih populacija vrsta ptica vodenih staništa korišćeni su samo rezultati popisa od 2012. do 2020. godine. Na osnovu pokrivenosti terena i zabeleženih brojnosti, izrazita fluktuacija brojnosti na zimovanju zabeležena je kod većeg broja vrsta vodenih staništa (ukupno 14 od 25): *Gavia arctica*, *Gavia stellata*, *Phalacrocorax carbo*, *Fulica atra*, *Alcedo atthis*, *Anser albifrons*, *Melanitta fusca*, *Aythya ferina*, *Aythya fuligula*, *Aythya marila*, *Anas crecca*, *Anas strepera*, *Anas penelope*, *Grus grus*.
- Trendovi populacija ptica šumskih i livadskih staništa izraženi su kroz procenjene populacije za četiri odvojene godine: 1990, 2003, 2008, 2013. i 2018, pri čemu su za 1990. i 2008. godinu brojnosti izračunate na osnovu procena iz 2003.

THE GOAL

To determine the long-term trends of the wetland, woodland and farmland bird populations on the territory of the Republic of Serbia.

ACTIVITIES

- *Among the wetland birds present in Serbia, 25 species were selected. To show the trend of their populations, two indicators were used - the size of breeding populations and the wintering population trend, based on the results of the International Waterbird Census. Only census results from 2012 to 2020 were used for the analysis of trends in wintering populations. Based on the field coverage and the recorded numbers, a marked fluctuation of numbers during wintering was recorded in a number of wetland species (14 out of 25 in total): *Gavia arctica*, *Gavia stellata*, *Phalacrocorax carbo*, *Fulica atra*, *Alcedo atthis*, *Anser albifrons*, *Melanitta fusca*, *Aythya ferina*, *Aythya fuligula*, *Aythya marila*, *Anas crecca*, *Anas strepera*, *Anas penelope*, *Grus grus*.*
- *The trends of woodland and farmland bird populations are expressed through the estimated populations for four separate years: 1990, 2003, 2008, 2013 and 2018, where for 1990 and 2008 the numbers were calculated based on estimates from 2003 and 2013. As indicators*



i 2013. godine. Kao indikatori za obe grupe prikazane su promene brojnosti u toku četiri godine (u vidu procentualne promene u odnosu na brojnost iz 1990.) i broj vrsta sa rastućim, opadajućim i stabilnim/fluktuirajućim trendom u periodu 1990-2003, 2008-2013. i 2013-2018. U okviru obe grupe uočeni su različiti obrasci promena populacija. Ipak, veći broj vrsta livadskih staništa pokazuje opadanje u odnosu na šumske vrste. Među šumskim vrstama više je onih sa stabilnom populacijom, dok je porast populacije nekih vrsta očigledan (npr. *Dryocopus martius*). Ipak, uočljive su i vrste sa izrazitim negativnim trendom (npr. *Accipiter gentilis*). Među livadskim vrstama najizraženiji negativni trend uočen je kod vrsta *Perdix perdix*, *Oenanthe oenanthe* i *Streptopelia turtur*.

for both groups, changes in abundance during four years (in the form of percentage changes compared to abundance in 1990) and the number of species with increasing, decreasing and stable/fluctuating trends in the period 1990-2003, 2008-2013 are shown. Within both groups, different patterns of population changes were observed. However, the greater number of species of farmland habitats shows a decline compared to woodland species. Among the woodland species, there are more of those with a stable population, while the increase in the population of some species is obvious (eg. *Dryocopus martius*). However, there are species with a distinct negative trend (eg. *Accipiter gentilis*). Among the farmland species, the most pronounced negative trend was observed in the *Perdix perdix*, *Oenanthe oenanthe* and *Streptopelia turtur*.

Ptice bez granica / Birds without borders

CILJ

Cilj projekta je edukacija dece o uticaju čoveka na migraciju ptica, kao i obeležavanje značajnih ekoloških datuma. Radionice su održane na Svetski dan zaštite životne sredine i u okviru obeležavanja Evropskog vikenda posmatranja ptica.

AKTIVNOSTI

- Održane su tri interaktivne radionice za decu osnovnoškolskog uzrasta u zaštićenom području „Veliko Blato“ na temu letenja i seobe ptica „Ptice bez granica“. Uz radionice su organizovane i edukativne šetnje sa posmatranjem ptica. U avgustu je organizovan istraživački kamp na kome je praćena seoba ptica putem markiranja. Na kamp je 9 istraživača, od kojih 3 licencirana prstenovača. Prstenvano je ukupno 2.849 jedinki ptica unutar 32 vrste. Najbrojnija je bila seoska lasta (*Hirundo rustica*). Među retkim nalazima je bio jedan ševarski trstenjak (*Acrocephalus melanopogon*), četiri siva barska petlića (*Porzana parva*), i jedan soko lastavčar (*Falco subbuteo*).

THE GOAL

The goal of the project is children education about the impact of people on the bird migration, as well as celebrating important ecological dates such as World Environment Day and Euro Birdwatch.

ACTIVITIES

- Three interactive workshops "Birds without borders" were organized for primary school children in the protected area "Veliko Blato" about the flying and migration. Educational walks with bird watching were organized after workshops. In August, a research camp was organized to monitor bird migration by ringing. There were 9 researchers, 3 of whom are licensed ringers. A total of 2,849 birds within 32 species were ringed. The most numerous was the Barn Swallow (*Hirundo rustica*). Among the rare findings were one Moustached Warbler (*Acrocephalus melanopogon*), four Little Crakes (*Porzana parva*), and a Hobby (*Falco subbuteo*).

Međunarodni popis ptica vodenih staništa / *International Waterbird Census(IWC)*

CILJ

Cilj popisa je da se dobiju podaci o brojnosti ptica vodenih staništa, trendovi njihovih populacija nakon više godina, kao i podaci o njihovim staništima, budućem upravljanju istih. Organizuje se svake godine u januaru.

AKTIVNOSTI

- Krajem januara 2021. završen je 55. Međunarodni zimski popis ptica vodenih staništa koji je trajao gotovo celog meseca. Preko 160 volontera intenzivno radilo je na obilasku više od 1.000 monitoring lokaliteta. Januar 2021. je ove zime bio nepredvidiv, baš kao i prethodnih sezona. Smene snega, kiše i jakih vetrova otežavale su planiranje i rad na terenu, ali su barem temperature uglavnom bile iznad nule. Velike reke ponovo smo pokrivali sa plovilima (Dunav, Sava, Tisa, Tamiš), dok je većina lokaliteta obilažena peške. Zajedno sa kolegama iz Hrvatske ponovo smo uspeli da u potpunosti obidemo reku Dunav, ali i brojne rukavce i vodoplavne zone duž celog toka kroz Srbiju. Najmnogoljudnije akcije bile su na području ušća Save u Dunav, duž vodotoka Zapadne Morave, kao i DTD kanala od Vrbasa do Bečeja. Brojano je i na Drini, Nišavi, Vidrenjaku, Čemernici, Velikoj Moravi, Grabovici, Limu, Zasavici, Jegrički, Timoku, Bosutu, Studenici, Peku. Ponovo smo uspeli da organizujemo brojanje na akumulaciji „Gazivode“ na Kosovu i Metohiji.
- Prema preliminarnim procenama u januaru 2021. zabeleženo je preko 280.000 ptica vodenih staništa. Ponovo su dve najbrojnije vrste bile gluvara (*Anas platyrhynchos*) i obični galeb (*Larus ridibundus*), a ponovo su bile

THE GOAL

The aim of the census is to obtain data on the abundance of waterbirds, trends in their populations after many years, as well as data on their habitats and the future management of these habitats. It is organized every year in January.

ACTIVITIES

- At the end of January 2021, the 55th International Waterbird Census was organized. It lasted almost the whole month. Over 160 volunteers worked intensively visiting more than 1,000 monitoring sites. January 2021 was unpredictable, similar to previous seasons. Alternations of snow, rain and high winds made planning and field work difficult, but at least the temperatures were mostly above freezing. We again covered the big rivers from boats (Danube, Sava, Tisa, Tamiš), while most of the localities were explored on foot. Together with our colleagues from Croatia, we once again managed to completely survey the Danube River, as well as numerous backwaters and flood zones along the entire course through Serbia. The most visited surveys were in the area of the confluence of the Sava and the Danube, along the West Morava watercourse, as well as the DTD canal from Vrbas to Bečej. Survey was also done on Drina, Nišava, Vidrenjak, Čemernica, Velika Morava, Grabovica, Lim, Zasavica, Jegrička, Timok, Bosut, Studenica, Pek. We again managed to organize a survey at the „Gazivoda“ reservoir in Kosovo and Metohija.
- According to preliminary estimates over 280,000 aquatic birds were recorded in January 2021. Again, the two most numerous species were Mallard (*Anas*



pronađene neke vrlo retke vrste za faunu Srbije. Na zimovanju kod nas po prvi put su potvrđene muljače (*Limosa limosa*) i argentinska zviždara (*Mareca sibilatrix*). Od ostalih veoma retkih vrsta na zimovanju beležene su: belobrke čigre (*Chlidonias hybrida*), ražanj (*Plegadis falcinellus*), gakovi (*Nycticorax nycticorax*), veliki crnoglavi galeb (*Larus ichtyaetus*), mali labudovi (*Cygnus columbianus*), veliki labudovi (*Cygnus cygnus*), baršunasti turpani (*Melanitta fusca*), srednji ronci (*Mergus serrator*), crni orlovi (*Clanga clanga*), riđogrli (*Podiceps grisegena*) i ušati gnjurci (*Podiceps auritus*), crvenonogi sprudnici (*Tringa erythropus*), zlatni vivci (*Pluvialis apricaria*) i druge. Alarmantno je što su na većini obidenih lokaliteta zabeležena različita ugrožavanja prirode – različita zagađenja, divlje deponije, krivolov i prekomerni lov, preoravanja staništa, priobalja reka, jezera i kanala su sve više degradirana, okupirana privatnim parcelama.

- Rad na terenu je bio podržan od strane više javnih preduzeća (JP „Vojvodinašume“, Direkcija za plovne puteve „Plovput“) i staratelja rezervata prirode širom zemlje.

Međunarodni popis ptica vodenih staništa predstavlja najstariji masovan popis ptica u svetu. Prvi put je organizovan u januaru 1967. godine, a od tada se tokom kratkog zimskog perioda (u januaru) simultano broje ptice na svim vodenim površinama u zapadnoj Evroaziji i Africi.

*platyrhynchos) and Black-headed Gull (*Larus ridibundus*), and again some very rare species for the fauna of Serbia were found. For the first time wintering in our country, Black-tailed Godwit (*Limosa limosa*) and Chiloe Wigeon (*Mareca sibilatrix*) were confirmed. Among other very rare and interesting wintering species, Whiskered Tern (*Chlidonias hybrida*), Glossy Ibis (*Plegadis falcinellus*), Black-crowned Night Heron (*Nycticorax nycticorax*), Great Black-headed Gulls (*Larus ichtyaetus*), Tundra Swans (*Cygnus columbianus*), Whooper Swans (*Cygnus cygnus*), Velvet Scoters (*Melanitta fusca*), Red-breasted Merganser (*Mergus serrator*), Greater Spotted Eagle (*Clanga clanga*), Red-necked Grebe (*Podiceps grisegena*) and Slavonian Grebe (*Podiceps auritus*), Spotted Redshank (*Tringa erythropus*), European Golden-Plover (*Pluvialis apricaria*) and others. It is alarming that in most of the visited localities various threats to nature have been recorded: various pollution; wild landfills; poaching and overhunting; illegal plowing; the banks of rivers, lakes and canals are increasingly degraded and occupied by private plots.*

- Field work was supported by several public companies (PE „Vojvodinašume“, Directorate for Inland Waterways – Plovput) and nature reserves managers throughout the country.

The International Waterbird Census is the oldest massive bird list in the world. It was first organized in January 1967, and since then, during the short winter period (in January), birds have been simultaneously counted on all water areas in western Eurasia and Africa.

Spring Alive

CILJ

Podsticanje dece širom Evrope, Azije i Afrike, njihovih porodica, prijatelja i nastavnika, da razumeju potrebu za očuvanje ptica selica. Takođe, ovaj program podstiče širu zajednicu da se uključi u zaštitu prirode kroz podršku BirdLife partnerima. Specifična tema 2021. godine bila je „Kako zaštитiti gnezda ptica?“.

AKTIVNOSTI

- U skladu sa specifičnom temom za 2021. godinu Društvo za zaštitu i proučavanje ptica Srbije je u Centru za likovnu i primenjenu umetnost „Terra“ u Kikindi održalo radionicu „Terra rustica“ u okviru koje su od gline ručno pravljena gnezda za seoske laste. Organizovano je peto po redu takmičenje „Domaćinstvo koje su laste izabrale“. U takmičenju su učestvovala 446 domaćinstva iz svih krajeva Srbije. Zbirno u svim domaćinstvima bilo je 3.566 aktivnih gnezda koja je nastanjivalo više od 21.000 seoskih lasta. Porodicu Crnojević iz Sremskih Karlovača osvojila je priznanje „Domaćinstvo koje su laste izabrale“. Ovi izvanredni domaćini na svom imanju imaju čak 101 gnezdo seoskih lasta. Pored priznanja domaćici Miri Crnojević uručen je 1.601 kilogram kukuruza kao nagrada za posvećeno čuvanje kolonije seoskih lasta. Između ostalih učesnika nasumičnim odabirom izvučen je dobitnik nagrade „Srećno gnezdo“. To je Živorad Marinković iz Starog Sela kod Velike Plane, kome je jedno gnezdo seoskih lasta donelo sreću i vaučer za kupovinu 60 sadnica voća.

THE GOAL

Encouraging children across Europe, Asia and Africa, their families, friends and teachers, to understand the need to conserve migratory birds. Also, this program encourages the wider community to get involved in nature conservation by supporting BirdLife partners. The specific theme of 2021 is "How to protect birds' nests?".

ACTIVITIES

- In accordance with the specific theme for 2021, BPSS held the workshop "Terra rustica" at the Center for Fine and Applied Arts "Terra" in Kikinda, during which nests for Barn Swallows were made by hand from clay. The fifth competition "Household chosen by swallows" was organized. In total 446 households from all over Serbia participated in it. Altogether, there were 3,566 active nests, inhabited by more than 21,000 Barn Swallows. The Crnojević family from Sremski Karlovci won the award "Household chosen by the swallows". These extraordinary hosts have as many as 101 Barn Swallow nests on their property. In addition to the recognition, the housewife Mira Crnojević was gifted with 1,601 kilograms of corn as a reward for dedicated care of a swallow colony. Among the other participants, the winner of the "Lucky Nest" award was randomly selected. This is Živorad Marinković from Staro Selo near Velika Plana, to whom a nest of swallows brought luck and a voucher for the purchase of 60 fruit seedlings.

Evropski vikend posmatranja ptica / European Birdwatching Weekend (EuroBirdwatch)

CILJ

Osnovni cilj je podizanje nivoa svesti građanstva o važnosti i potrebi zaštite ptica selica, kao i očuvanja područja gde se razmnožavaju, odmaraju tokom migracija i područja koja koriste kao zimovališta.

AKTIVNOSTI

- Evropski vikend posmatranja ptica 2021. godine organizovan je 2. i 3. oktobra. Društvo za zaštitu i proučavanje ptica Srbije je u susret Evropskom vikendu posmatranja ptica organizovalo onlajn kurs posmatranja ptica „Ptice na dlanu“ na kome je učestvovalo ukupno 392 učesnika. Cilj kursa je bio da se učesnici kroz pet, posebno osmišljenih, onlajn predavanja pripreme za samostalan i odgovoran boravak u prirodi prilikom posmatranja ptica. Predavanja su se održavala na Facebook stranici i YouTube kanalu Društva za zaštitu i proučavanje ptica Srbije, gde su i sada dostupna. U okviru Evropskog vikenda posmatranja ptica organizовано je ukupno 26 izleta posmatranja ptica na kojima je učestvovalo 935 učesnika. Posmatrano je ukupno 134 vrsta ptica među kojima je bilo 37.435 jedinki ptica.

Evropski vikend posmatranja ptica je događaj koji je prvi put organizovan još davne 1993. godine u Velikoj Britaniji. Tada je oformljena organizacija pod imenom BirdLife International sa sedištem u Velikoj Britaniji, a pomenuti događaj (tada pod nazivom "World Birdwatch") je bio jedna od prvih aktivnosti nove organizacije. Uskoro se događaju pridružuju partneri BirdLife-a iz Evrope, kada svako u svojoj državi organizuje istu aktivnost. Ceo događaj je doživeo veliku popularnost i neverovatan uspeh, zbog čega se narednih godina nastavilo sa organizovanjem iste aktivnosti širom Evrope. Evropski vikend posmatranja ptica sada je već tradicija.

EuroBirdwatch is an event first organized back in 1993 in the UK. A UK-based organization called BirdLife International was formed in the same year, and the event (then called "World Birdwatch") was one of the first activities of the new organization. Not long after that, BirdLife partners from Europe joined the event and started to organize the same activity in their respective countries. The whole event had achieved great popularity and incredible success, which is why it continued to be organized throughout Europe in the following years. EuroBirdwatch is now a tradition.



THE GOAL

The main goal was to raise awareness about the need and importance of saving migratory birds, conserving their breeding areas, stopovers on migration routes and wintering grounds.

ACTIVITIES

- *The European Birdwatching Weekend 2021 was organized on October 2 and 3. BPSSS organized an online birdwatching course "Birds in the Palm" in anticipation of the European Birdwatching Weekend, in which a total of 392 participants took part. The goal of the course was to prepare the participants through five specially designed online lectures for an independent and responsible stay in nature while observing birds. The lectures were held on the Facebook page and YouTube channel of BPSSS, where they are still available. As part of the European Birdwatching Weekend, a total of 26 birdwatching trips were organized with 935 participants. A total of 134 species of birds were observed, among which there were 37,435 individual birds.*

Tim za borbu protiv krivolova Serbian Bird Crime Task Force

Tim čine članovi DZPPSa koji zajedno deluju na otkrivanju slučaja krivolova na ptice u Republici Srbiji i bore se da se ova loša praksa, koja izuzetno šteti našoj prirodi, maksimalno suzbije. Aktivnosti Tima sprovode se tokom cele godine, različitim intenzitetom u zavisnosti od potrebe. Tim je osnovan 2015. godine.

- institucijama su prijavljena ukupno 44 slučaja kršenja zakona;
- zabeleženo je ukupno 55 slučajeva krivolova prepelica uz korišćenje elektronskih vabilica;
- pronađeno je 98 elektronskih vabilica za prepelice.

The team consists of members of the BPSSS who work together to detect the cases of bird poaching in the Republic of Serbia, and fight to eliminate this bad practice, which is extremely damaging to our nature. Team activities are conducted throughout the whole year, with varying intensity depending on need. The team was established in 2015.

- All together 44 cases of bird crimes were reported to the authorities;
- A total of 55 cases of Common Quail poaching with the use of calling devices were recorded;
- A total of 98 electronic calling devices were found.





The membership index is the percentage change in relation to the previous year




Članska karta za 2019. / Membership card for 2019

Značajno vreme u našem radu posvećujemo odgovaranju na pozive i pisanja građana, medija, institucija, udruženja i kompanija. DZPPS pomenutim subjektima pruža potrebne informacije, savete i daje podršku za različite aktivnosti. Ovi kontakti ostvaruju se putem telefonskih poziva na brojeve u našim kancelarijama u Novom Sadu i Beogradu, potom kroz imejl prepisku i u porukama na društvenoj mreži Facebook. U cilju praćenja potreba subjekata koji nam se javljaju, prikupljamo podatke o datumu, lokaciji i razlogu javljanja. Razloge javljanja podelili smo u 22 kategorije. Posebno vredni su nam podaci o nalazima jedinki divljih ptica (žive i mrtve) i slučajevima kršenja zakona.

We dedicate significant time in our work to responding to calls and writings of citizens, media, institutions, CSOs and companies. BPSSS provides the necessary information, advice and support to various entities for various activities. These contacts are made through phone calls to numbers in our offices in Novi Sad and Belgrade, then through email correspondence and in messages on the social network Facebook. In order to monitor the needs of the subjects who contact us, we collect data on the date, location and reason for contacting. We divided the reasons for contacting into 22 categories. The data on wild birds records (living and dead) and illegalities are especially valuable to us.









DZPPS I PTICE U MEDIJIMA / BPSSS AND BIRDS IN THE MEDIA

Najveći broj izazova sa kojima se susrećemo u zaštiti ptica i prirode proistekli su iz loše informisanosti i manjka znanja određenih društvenih grupa. Jedan od stateški važnih ciljeva našeg rada jeste povećanje znanja šire javnosti o potrebi za istraživanjem i zaštitom ptica i prirode. U formiranju javnog mnjenja posebno važnu ulogu imaju masovni mediji. Da bismo izmerili naš uticaj na kreiranje javnog mnjenja kroz medijske priloge u štampanim, TV, radio i internet medijima, sprovedeno je istraživanje uglavnom kroz plaćenu uslugu press clippinga, manjim delom kroz sopstvenu pretragu medijskih sadržaja. Ključni pojmovi koji su praćeni u medijskim objavama su: 1) Dušto za zaštitu i proučavanje ptica Srbije; 2) divlje ptice; 3) krivolov.


Most of the challenges we face in the areas of bird and nature conservation originate from poor information and lack of knowledge of certain social groups. One of the strategically important goals of our work is to increase the knowledge of the general public about the need for research and conservation of birds and nature. The mass media have a particularly important role in shaping public opinion. In order to measure our influence on the creation of public opinion through media reports in printed, TV, radio and internet media, the research was conducted mainly through a paid press clipping service, to a lesser extent through our own search of media content. The key terms that are followed in media publications are: 1) Birds Protection and Study Society of Serbia; 2) wild birds; 3) poaching.




